



**BYLAW 407-19**  
**A BYLAW IN THE VILLAGE OF MILO IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**  
**TO AMEND BYLAW 396-16**

**NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MILO DULY ASSEMBLED HEREBY AMENDS BYLAW 396-16 TO READ AS FOLLOWS, TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING FEES, CHARGES, FINES AND PENALTIES:**

The Village is assuming its cost of treated water to be **\$2.98** per cubic meter. The cost will vary according to the type of utility notice being issued. There are four types of ratepayers for purposes of billing for utility services: residential, commercial, non-resident connection and bulk water.

All fees will be billed monthly except bulk water users who will only be billed for the months wherein they occur usage. The following fees will apply contingent on the type of utility notice being used:

**ADMIN FEE-\$14.00/MONTH:** Every utility notice will include a set fee for costs of administration. This fee is to cover the costs incurred by the village for administering utilities such as billing materials including but not limited to software, man hours, paper products and stamps

**DISTRIBUTION FEE- \$8.00/MONTH:** Resident, Commercial and non-resident connections will be charged a set fee for the use, repair, and replacement of waterlines in the village. This fee is necessary to collect funds to maintain the water distribution system.

**SEWER - \$15.00/MONTH:** Residential and Commercial ratepayers will pay a set fee of \$15.00/month for the use, repair and maintenance of sewer lines in the Village. This fee is necessary to collect funds to assist in maintaining the sewer system.

**GARBAGE-\$25.00/MONTH:** Residential and Commercial ratepayers will pay a set fee of \$25.00/month to cover costs associated with garbage disposal. This rate is to regenerate revenue covering costs associated with the annual membership in the Vulcan and District Waste Management Commission, and the garbage pickup service provided in the village.

**WATER RATES-\$2.98/CUBIC METER:** Residential, Commercial and Non-Resident Connection ratepayers will be charged the full cost recovery rate of \$2.98/cu m including but not limited to the implemented minimum 8 cubic meters/month

**MINIMUM USAGE AMOUNT:** The Village has implemented the minimum usage rate of 8 cubic meters/month to encourage residents to water lawns, gardens and trees. Minimum usage rates will also assist in more accurate water production projections and budgeting.

**BULK WATER RATE-\$6.60/CUBIC METER:** There is no change in this rate from previous years. The Village did not raise this rate because bulk water sales continue to generate a healthy profit. The Village recognizes that bulk water customers also incur transportation costs for hauling water.

The above rates and minimums shall commence as of 12:00 am, June 1, 2019

All prior bylaws to amend Schedule A of Bylaw 376-12, including Bylaw 396-16, are hereby rescinded and replaced with this schedule of rates.
