



VILLAGE OF MILO
2018 PROPERTY TAX BYLAW No. 400-18

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF MILO FOR THE 2018 TAXATION YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Village of Milo has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the 2018 municipal revenue, expenses and expenditures as required, at the Council Meeting held on Tuesday May 15, 2018 and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues from all sources other than property taxation total **\$914,104.00** and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenses (excluding non-cash items) set out in the annual budget for the Village of Milo for 2018 total **\$1,118,503.00** and the balance of **\$206,399.00** is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and

WHEREAS, the estimated amount required to repay principle debt to be raised by general municipal taxation is **\$5,200.00** and

WHEREAS, the estimated amount required for fiscal reserves to be raised by municipal taxation is **\$25,000.00** and

THEREFORE, the total amount to be raised by general municipal taxation is **\$173,962.00** and

WHEREAS, the requisitions are:

WHEREAS, the Council is authorized to classify assessed property, and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each class of property, subject to the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 and

WHEREAS, the assessed value of all property in the Village of Milo as shown on the assessment roll in:

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Village of Milo, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all taxable property as shown on the assessment roll of the Village of Milo:


