

BY-LAW # 328

A By-Law of the Village of Milo with regards to the restraining of dogs running at large.

WHEREAS, it is expedient to repeal and revise the existing By-Law of the Village dealing with the regulating and controlling of Dogs and with the ownership of dogs in the Village.

NOW THEREFORE: Under the Powers conferred upon it pursuant to Section 164 (b) of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Village of Milo, duly assembled:

ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. that this By-law be cited as " The Dog By-Law of the Village of Milo.

2. **Definitions** in this by-law, including this Section, unless the context otherwise requires, words shall have meaning as follows:

- (a) "Village" means the Village of Milo"
- (b) "Dog" means either a male, female or spayed female.
- (c) "Owner" means the person who has legal title to the dog, and also any person who has the possession or custody of the dog, or harbors the dog, or suffers the dog to remain on his or her premises.
- (d) "Council" means the Village Council for the Municipal Corporation of the Village of Milo.
- (e) "Running at Large" means any dog which is off the premises of its owner and is not on a leash or under other immediate continuous control of some competent person.

3. Running at Large - No owner of any dog shall permit or suffer such dog to run at large in the Village of Milo.

4. Fines imposed on the owners of dogs found running at large.

(a) when a written complaint is received by an official of the Village from two or more residents of the Village - the owner of the dog SHALL pay to the Secretary-Treasurer a fine.

1. \$ 50.00 for the First offense, \$ 75.00 for the Second offense, and \$ 150.00 for the Third offense and for each offense thereafter.

2. Fines are to be paid within thirty (30) days of billing. Overdue fines will be added to the owners water bill.

AND FURTHER THAT

1. By-Law # 253 is hereby rescinded.

2. This By-Law shall have the effect from the date of the Final passing thereof.

READ A FIRST time this 19th day of July 1999.

READ A SECOND time this 19th day of July 1999.

READ A THIRD and FINAL time this 19th day of July 1999.
